Scenario 1 - ES

You're playing a game to practice some vocabulary with your students. As the game progresses, the class' volume and behaviour gradually get out of hand. Now, you're having a hard time getting everyone to return their focus to the game.

Scenario 2 - JHS

You and your JTE have just greeted the class. You are standing at the front of the classroom and are about to start your activity, but your students start talking amongst themselves. You stand there, trying to make eye contact with a few students, but the students don't seem to get the hint.

Scenario 3 - JHS

You are reading a passage from the textbook with your students. You notice that some students are mocking your pronunciation and are repeating after you in an exaggerated manner. Your JTE moves to stand closer to the students but they continue with their behaviour.
