

Poster Making for Students: An Easy and Creative Classroom Activity

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Posters give students opportunities to integrate their visual learning styles with textbook content. Students create, present and visually display their ideas in poster presentations. In this workshop, the focus is on demonstrating why, what, and how a poster activity brings active learning into the classroom. Popular content topics in textbooks are used. Participants will collaboratively design and present their posters to get a sense of how to manage a poster activity. Time will be given for reflective discussions and questions.

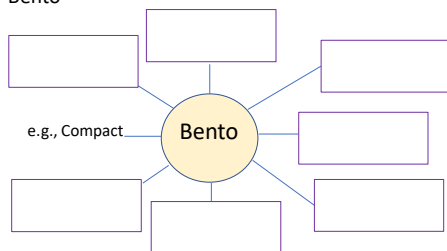

Scaffolding the International Bento activity

➤ Goal: Participants create, design and present international bento concept

1. Brainstorm: Write what comes to your mind about bento
2. Readings to provide content for activity
3. Students are put into groups
4. Problem based task: Design a poster on worksheet then on poster size paper (poster paper and *copy* color pencils will be provided)
5. Make a presentation script
6. Present posters in rotation sequence
7. Evaluate posters in rotation sequence

1. Brainstorm: Write what comes to your mind about Bento



2. Readings to provide content for activity:

Participants will briefly have time to look at material for poster activity to get ideas for poster:

- (1) Reading on international bento from a high school textbook;
- (2) Short reading on attractiveness and health benefits of bento.

Collaborative Workshop Activity

3. Participants work together to do task
4. Problem based task: Design a poster on worksheet then on poster size paper (poster paper and *copy* color pencils will be provided)
5. Make a short presentation script
6. Present posters in rotation sequence
7. Evaluate posters in rotation sequence
8. Discussion on usefulness of posters in your classes
